4. **V** - To approve the Consent Agenda:
 - a) Authorizing the installation of security fencing around the Public Works building located at 83 Duncan Circle, by Contractors of West Georgia, in an amount not to exceed \$77,860.75, to be paid for by Street SPLOST.
 - b) Authorizing the use of Gray's Mill Park for the 2022 Faith and Blue Weekend, October 7 - 9, 2022.
 - c) Authorizing the City Manager to authorize use of Public Property for filming activities.
 - d) Authorizing contracting with Atwell, LLC to design the Parking Lot and Veterans Memorial area behind City Hall, in an amount not to exceed \$3,850.00, to be funded by Street SPLOST.
 - e) Authorizing the surplus and trade of the Ford Econoline Van and Transit Van, to Wade Green Ford (State Contract Vendor), at a value of \$37,000, to be applied toward the purchase and outfitting of a 2022 Ford Explorer from Wade Green Ford, with the remaining balance of outfitting to be paid for by General Fund, not to exceed \$5,000.00.

 - 3) Accept Option #1 and proceed sending sanitation services out for bid; staying

with GFL until new contract goes into effect

4) Accept Option #2 and proceed sending sanitation services out for bid; staying with GFL until new contract goes into effect

5) Accept Option #1 and work towards moving sanitation in-house; staying with GFL until in-house service is ready to be implemented

6) Accept Option #2 and work towards moving sanitation in-house; staying with GFL until in-house service is ready to be implemented

7) Leave sanitation rates the same, remove recycling, work towards moving sanitation in-house; staying with GFL until in-house service is ready to be implemented

8) Leave sanitation rates the same, remove recycling, send sanitation out for bid; staying with GFL until new contract goes into effect

9) Stay with current service contractor, GFL, for a 3-year contract, increase sanitation rates no less than 10%, eliminate recycling

10) Stay with current service contractor, GFL, for a 3-year contract, increase sanitation rates no less than 10%, add monthly fee of no less than \$5.00 for recycling
